Spring has (finally) sprung in North Idaho! And with that comes spring clothing... here are the Dress Code Reminders for Washington Elementary:

>Shorts and skirts must be as long as the person's fingertips with the arms hanging down at sides. Pants with holes in them must be no higher than a person's fingertips with the arms down hanging down at sides.

> Shoulder straps must be two fingers wide (no spaghetti straps). Tank top straps must also cover undergarments. Halter tops are not permitted. Shirts with shoulder holes cannot show undergarments. No low necklines, halter tops or half shirts (no bare midribs or backs).

>No clothing that advertises alcohol, tobacco, drugs or is gang related.

> No clothing or accessories with suggestive, obscene, or violent writing or pictures.

> Shoes must be worn at all times. Very sturdy sandals with backs are acceptable. No flip-flops or backless shoes. We also highly encourage close-toed sandals.

>No hats or visors are to be worn in the hallways or cafeteria. Hats may be allowed in classrooms per teacher discretion.

>No make-up.

***Students who do not abide by these dress code guidelines may be asked to change or turn shirts inside out. Parents may also be called to bring an appropriate change of clothes.
